

# Plein Air Painting with Linda Richichi

If you have seen painters outdoors capturing nature and want to join in or heighten your skill level, then this is the class for you! Linda Richichi has taught thousands of beginners in NY and has taken groups to Italy to paint for over a decade. She has simplified the process of painting outdoors by breaking it down into easy steps to follow.

Meet on location. First you'll have a group lesson in the basic fundamentals of setting up, making a quick study, the 5 tips to using atmospheric perspective and finally simplifying color. If raining, we work under a porch.

On location, begin with a quick study to decide on composition and values. Then create the illusion of depth on canvas by blocking out simple shapes. Enjoy one on one instruction. Gain a better understanding of how to use color to create convincing light and shadow areas adding energy to your work.
