

Jacquard iDye Sun Blocker Instructions

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Easy to use soluble packet.

Sun Blocker can be used on most 100% natural fabrics (silk, cotton, linen, rayon). Not for synthetic fabrics. It will penetrate clothing fibers to help block out up to 96% of the sun's harmful UV rays. One treatment lasts for up to 20 washings.

One packet treats 2 to 3 pounds (1 - 1.3 kg) of fabric.

FOR BEST RESULTS:

Prewash garment to remove any sizings, softeners or finishes.

NOTE:

Utensils and pot used for this process should not be used for food.

THREE SIMPLE STEPS FOR PERFECT RESULTS:

- 1. Fill washing machine with just enough hot water for the fabric to move freely.
- 2. Add iDye Sun Blocker soluble packet and dissolve, then add fabric.
- 3. Run the garment through wash cycle and dry.

AN ALTERNATE METHOD:

- I. Fill bucket or tub with enough hot water to cover fabric.
- 2. Add iDye Sun Blocker soluble packet and dissolve, then add fabric.
- 3. Soak for at least 15 minutes. Agitate frequently to ensure even absorption of Sun Blocker.
- 4. Rinse garment and dry.

iDye Sun Blocker:

- Safe for children's clothing for children over 6 months old.
- Safe for people with sensitive skin.
- · Effective on clothing wet or dry.
- Will not change the softness or texture of the fabric.
- Blocks out 96% of harmful ultraviolet rays.
- Has a UPF (Ultraviolet Protection Factor) rating of 30.

Caution:

Keep out of reach of children. Avoid inhalation and contact with eyes.

Danger!

CORROSIVE. Causes eye burns. Contains UV Absorber. Keep away from eyes. Wash hands after handling. If eye contact occurs, flush with plenty of water. Call physician immediately.
