

## The Figure in Color

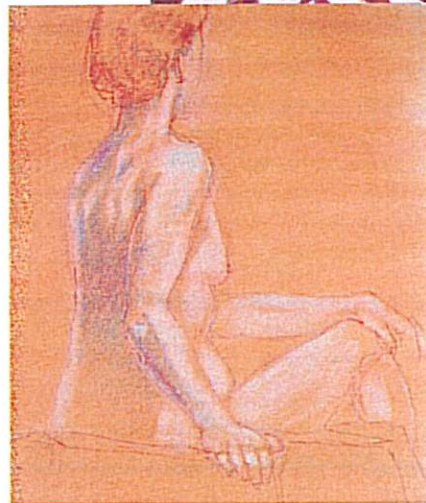
### Larry Forgard

This 6 week drawing course focuses on using dry material color to complete and enhance the beauty of the nude figure form. Exploration of the general proportion, form, value and gesture will be studied to help in the final studies. Limited color and full color will be introduced using a variety of materials. Dry materials such as pastel, charcoal and conte' will be covered on a variety of papers. This course uses live models situated in simple background environments to help students in the understanding of composition and to work on artwork that can later be framed. Short poses are introduced early in the class with longer poses added to complete colored pieces. Students with some basic figure drawing experience will benefit the most since this covers color material rather than the most basic figure drawing. Class requires a 10 person minimum to cover the cost of a live model each week.



#### About the Artist:



**LARRY FORGARD** was born and raised in Chicago, Illinois. Larry Forgard is a prolific artist who categorizes his work as "reality based abstraction." Forgard studied at the renowned Art Institute of Chicago in the early 1960s followed by a spell at the American Academy of Art in the same city. Forgard later became a college instructor at the Ringling College of Art and Design in Sarasota, Florida. His lectures and courses are well-received, as is his art, which has been displayed in dozens of group, juried, and solo exhibitions over the years. Forgard has also earned a number of awards and his paintings can be found in private collections across the country.
