Come enjoy an introduction to the fabulous world of the scratchboarding. Learn basic techniques using a variety of different tools and how to bring your image to life.

In the first hour of this 5 hour of class you will learn about the different scratchboard materials that can be used for your etching. A practice board will be supplied to each student to allow them to try out different tools and techniques.

Experiment with the different effects such as fur, stippling, cross hatching, ect.

In the remaining time in class you will transfer an image to a 5x7 Ampersand Scratchbord. Doing the same image will allow the instructor to give step by step instruction to the students as well as have time with each person for one on one instructions.
